What's Required?

Why Submit?

- The student author or co-authors selected will receive an award of \$250 per accepted manuscript, with the cover story receiving \$500.
- Students selected for publication will receive one-on-one coaching focused on communicating complex information to a lay audience.
- Research published in InnovatED is shared widely, reaching readers in more than 45 countries.

Application Materials

- Curriculum vitae
- Statement of research interests (up to two pages) reflecting commitment to leading-edge interdisciplinary neuroscientific/biomedical research and indicating [two potential co-mentors](#) from the faculty of the Gladstone Institute of Neurological Disease
- Description of long-term career goals (half a page)
- Three letters of reference from current or former mentors
