Mentors can nominate a senior graduate student performing stem cell research for an Award and travel costs to attend UW-Madison's Graduate Student Stem Cell and Regenerative Medicine Research Symposium that will be held over two days concurrently with the **21st annual Wisconsin Stem Cell Symposium on April 14-15, 2026**. The theme this year is "Decoding the Regenerative Dialogue Between Inflammatory and Stem Cell Pathways."

Selected students for the **2026 Wisconsin Stem Cell Graduate Scholar Awards** will present their work and attend the symposium, have the opportunity to meet with faculty as potential postdoc mentors, and visit and tour Madison. Applicants should be senior graduate students defending their thesis between summer 2026 and summer 2027, and have not committed to a postdoctoral position before the symposium is held. **The deadline for application is January 31, 2026.**
