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Abstract Submission and Poster Presentation

Abstract Submission:

Abstract submission deadline is **June 17, 2022 (5:00pm ET - close of business)**. Abstracts are limited to **300 words**, excluding title, authors and affiliations. All abstracts should be submitted as a Word document. **Abstracts larger than 300 words will not be accepted.** For guidelines on writing an abstract, please refer to the "Guidelines for Writing an Abstract-Diabetes Symposium" document attached to the registration announcement email.

General Formatting:

- Please submit abstract as a Word document
- 1" margins
- Arial 11 font
- Left justify all text
- No tabs at the beginning of a paragraph
- Do not write text in all capital letters
- Single line spacing
- Structured or unstructured formats are acceptable

Categories:

Abstracts are to be in one of the following categories:

- Metabolism/Physiology
- Clinical Research
- Islet Biology/Pancreas
- Immunology
- Neuroscience
- Other (if other, please explain)

If submitting an abstract, please indicate on the registration form whether you are willing to present in the Oral Abstracts Session. If you select "no," your abstract will be evaluated for poster presentation. A total of 20 abstracts will be selected for the Oral Presentations session.

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Poster Guidelines:

Poster Specifications and Mounting Information:

- Mount posters on assigned board in MS atrium prior to 12:00pm
- Posters must be removed immediately after poster session ends at 2:15pm
- Posters must not exceed 4' vertical and 8' horizontal
- Lettering should not be less than 1-1/2"
- Illustrations should be similar to those you would use in making slides but more heavily drawn
- One or two authors *must* be present during presentation times
- Velcro tabs/pushpins will be provided

Name Badges and Conference Material:

Conference materials will be sent via email. Name badges can be picked up Friday, August 5 starting at 8am at the registration table, located on the 2nd floor of the Joseph E. Scientific Presentations:

Most scientific presentations will be held in the R3 Auditorium (2nd floor). First session begins at 8:50am.

Oral Abstract Session:

Based on request of past attendees, this year's Symposium will include an Oral Abstract session, where trainees will present their work. A total of 20 abstracts will be selected for oral presentation, based on review of the quality/contents of abstracts by a panel of judges. If you would like your abstract considered for an oral presentation, please check "yes" on the registration form. Please refer to the "Guidelines for Writing an Abstract-Diabetes Symposium" document attached to the registration announcement email for information/recommendations on writing a compelling abstract.

Poster Session:

The Poster Session is scheduled from 12:45pm - 2:15pm in the Van Nuys Medical Science (MS) Building atrium. Boards are numbered and reserved for each poster. 1 or 2 authors must be present at all times during the poster session. Please ensure posters are mounted on boards prior to 12:00pm and removed immediately after the poster session ends at 2:15pm. Any posters left after the poster session will be destroyed.

Awards:

Posters will be reviewed and scored by a panel of judges and awards presented during the afternoon Poster Awards session.

Meals:

Online registration includes breakfast and lunch (**for symposium attendees only**). Breakfast will be in the R3 building atrium from 8:00am - 8:45am. Lunch will be in the MS building atrium from 12:15pm - 2:15pm. (**Name badges are required for meals**).
