



The Dimitris N. Chorafas Award

Purdue University will nominate one young PhD graduate student researcher for the 2022 Chorafas Foundation Award. The **\$5,000** award, made available by the Dimitris N. Chorafas Foundation, is intended as a prize for advanced studies and/or research during or shortly after graduation. The Dimitris N. Chorafas Foundation was founded in 1992 under the leadership of Prof. Dimitris N. Chorafas. Each year, the Foundation awards prizes to more than 20 universities, with the goal of stimulating promising young researchers.

CALL FOR PRE-PROPOSALS

Selection of a Purdue nominee will be a two-phase process. Students are invited to submit pre-proposals for the Chorafas Foundation Award by

Monday, April 11, 2022.

A maximum of 5 finalists will be selected to submit a full nomination package.

Life Sciences & Medicine

Physics

Chemistry (including nanotechnology)

Mathematics

Informatics/Computer Science

Engineering of Finance & Risk Management)
