- Weldon IBSc PhD students may use Student Research Talks (BME Bytes) as one of the two BME seminars required for their degree program.
- Student Research Talks (BME Bytes) speakers are not required to register for BME 69000 unless planning to use it as one of their required seminars.
- Non-BME graduate students should note that a course for which a letter grade is not earned will not fulfill plan of study requirements.
- Everyone is welcome and encouraged to attend the Student Research Talks (BME Bytes) presentations whether registered or not.

Registered students:

To receive a grade of satisfactory, you must:

1. Attend at least 12 sessions during the summer semester. In order to receive credit for attending, you must be in the room no later than 1:35 pm and stay for the entire session (no leaving early). There will be a sign in sheet you will need to sign before it is pulled at 1:35 pm.
2. Fill out a Qualtrics feedback survey after each presentation by 11:59 pm on the same Friday of the presentation. A link for each presenter will be in Brightspace each week. A QR code will also be available each week during the presentation.
