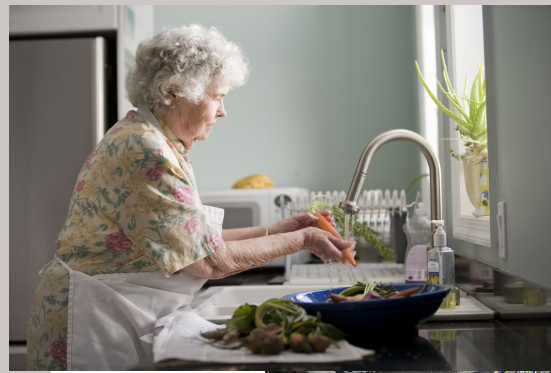

DISSEMINATION AND IMPLEMENTATION SCIENCE

There is a 17 year lag between research innovation and practice in public health; it takes 17 years to turn original research to the benefit of people.

The translation of evidence-based interventions into practice to improve population health outcomes is a common theme, but the process of distribution of scientific findings, materials, and associated resources is less developed.

The intent of implementation and dissemination research is to spread knowledge and associated interventions, and build understanding of approaches to increased effectiveness of dissemination efforts. In this course you will learn the necessary methods to conceptualize and initiate implementation science research projects.
