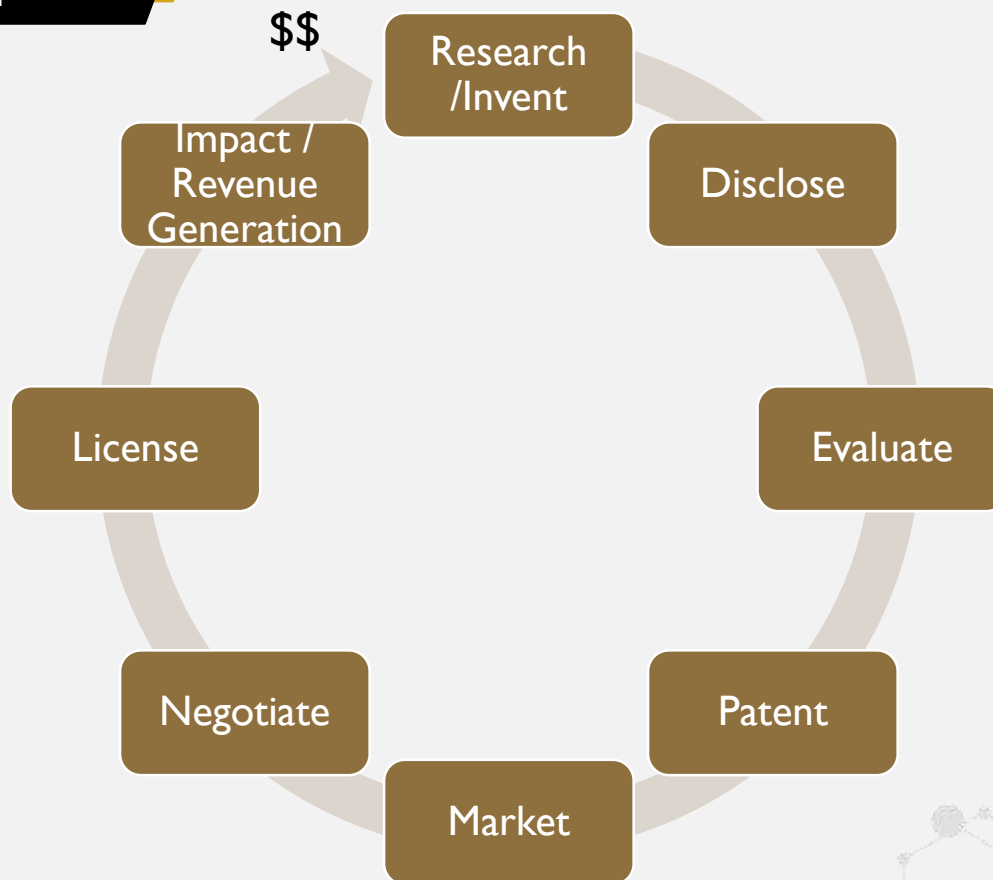

How To submit a disclosure TO OTC



1. OTC Website (<https://www.prf.org/otc/>) → Disclosure Form
2. Click “Purdue Inventors Click Here”
3. Login with your Purdue career account
4. Click on “New Disclosure”
5. Fill out form

WHAT IS A DISCLOSURE?

- A confidential description of the new discovery/innovation submitted to OTC.
- Allows OTC to assess the patentability and market potential
- All Purdue Intellectual Property must be disclosed to OTC according to policy I.A.1 ()

WHO SHOULD DISCLOSE?

- Anyone subject to Purdue's IP Policy
 - Faculty
 - Students
 - Visiting Scholars
- **“IP that arises in any part in the course of employment or enrollment at the University, or in the course of a work-for-hire relationship or visiting scholar relationship with the University, is Purdue IP...”**
- Some exceptions:
 - Certain student IP
 - Certain copyrighted material

Purdue IP policy- exception: Student IP

The University permits a student to retain title to Intellectual Property that the student creates for credit and **without compensation** in a University course through the use of **course-wide resources**, provided that the Intellectual Property is not burdened by any **pre-existing contractual obligation** of the University.
