- ❖ The Center for Integrated Nanotechnologies (CINT) is a user facility managed by the DOE Office of Science and operated jointly by Los Alamos National Laboratories and Sandia National Laboratories.
- ❖ Sandia provides an opportunity for graduate and undergraduate students to participate in an 8-week summer research program at CINT in Albuquerque, NM.
- ❖ Sandia's scientists will partner with students and their faculty advisors to develop CINT user proposals and determine summer research.
- ❖ Participating students will receive mentorship from CINT scientists, tours of Sandia facilities, career discussions with Sandia, and opportunities to participate in other student-focused activities.
- ❖ This program fosters long-term scientific collaborations between CINT scientists, faculty and students.
