

RCHE is now accepting proposals for

2010 RCHE Seed Grants

Two excellent opportunities:

- *Research seed grant:* Projects that after the one-year seed grant will be competitive for external funding.
- *Implementation seed grant:* Implementing research results in a clinical or other applicable real-world setting to demonstrate the impact of the research.

Eligibility

Faculty and researchers at all Purdue campuses are eligible.

About the grant

Seed grants are for \$40,000 each. All grant monies must be used by June 30, 2011. Up to six research grants and three implementation grants will be awarded.

Topics

Topics are open; however, preference will be given to research seed grant applications in the priority areas of care coordination or population health, and implementation seed grant applications in which the initial research was conducted through RCHE.

Submission

All proposals must use the RCHE proposal template, available at www.purdue.edu/rche/research/funding.php

The PI and project title listed on the LOI must remain the same for the proposal.

Deadlines

January 20, 2010: Letter of Intent due

February 17, 2010: Proposal due

April 2, 2010: Grant recipients notified
