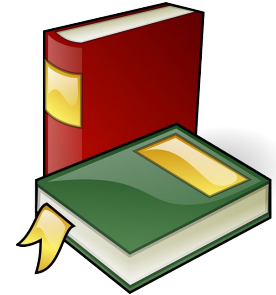


MATTHEW EDWARD KERN ENVIRONMENTAL ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP
