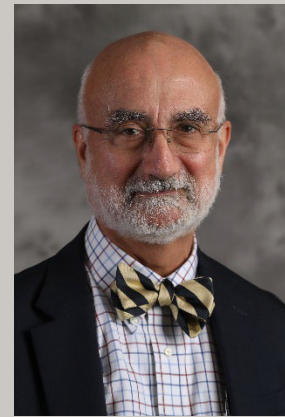


International Standards Organization

Over 50 nations provide representatives to ISO-TC267, the technical committee developing standards for facilities management. They have been working on standards since 2010 and during that time have developed over twelve standards or technical reports outlining best practices in facility management. The presentation will cover standards that have been developed and how they are being used as well as standards that are still being drafted.
