She earned her Master's and PhD degrees in Environmental Engineering from Purdue University, is a Licensed Professional Engineer in Indiana, a Certified Hazardous Materials Manager, and a LEED accredited professional. She assists and advises the University with environmental compliance and policy matters associated with state and federal regulations, including the Clean Air Act and the Clean Water Act. She also provides technical guidance and recommendations to a number of University operations including the University's Wade Utility Plant, Purdue Agricultural Centers, and other campus operations.
