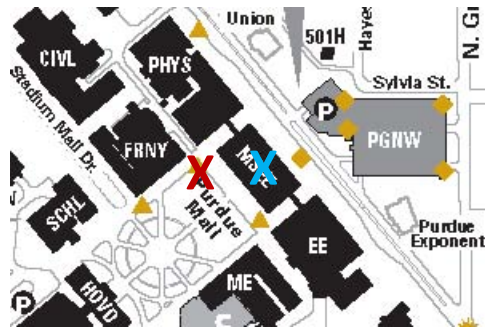


Emergency Procedures – Forney

Fire alarm: Evacuation



X – Evacuation gathering point during normal weather conditions

X – Evacuation gathering point during inclement weather (rain, snow, etc.)

Procedure:

- Calmly proceed to the nearest exit. Exits are located on the ground and first floors.
- Do not use the elevators.
- Take your personal belongings, if possible.
- Assist those who need help, if possible.
- **Once outside, go to the evacuation gathering point: X or X**
- Stay outside until instructed that it is safe to re-enter the building.

Siren: Shelter-in-place

Procedure (weather related incident):

- Calmly move to the basement of either the new or the old wing of the building.
- Do not use the elevators

Procedure (hazardous materials release, or a civil disturbance):

- Shelter in the classroom, turn off lights, lock or secure doors. Hide under the desk, if needed.
- Stay in the shelter location until instructed that it is safe to leave.**
