Then welcome to "**Experiential Learning in Asia: An Immersive Faculty Development Program**"

This is an innovative new program that provides an immersive experience for faculty. Focused on experiential learning, this 8-day program enables faculty to develop their own course while actively engaging with urban and rural environments in India.

This program is designed to provide faculty with the background to create experiential learning courses in the Asian context, including curriculum design, reflection exercises and assessment tools. Workshop facilitators include experts and practitioners with both global and local experiences.

Covering three major destinations, the program begins in Mumbai where participants will interact with entrepreneurs both in the financial district and Dharavi in one of Asia's largest slums. Participants then travel to Dahanu, a beautiful coastal town from where one can experience a village life. The program ends in Delhi with glimpses of history and culture.

This program is conducted by Authentica, an experiential learning company based in Pune, India that has delivered over 70 programs in 16 countries across Asia for over 2000 participants from the US, Canada and Australia.
