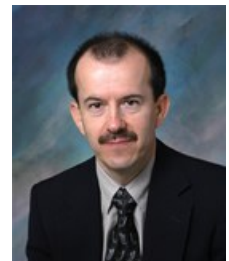
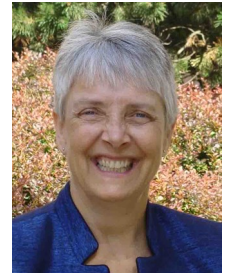
# Mentoring: *Cultivating Relationships*
