***“The Entrepreneurial Journey, How My Research
at Purdue University Led to My Career”***

Abstract

As a research student in the Chemistry Department working with Dr. R.G. Cooks, I helped develop a novel mass analyzer and spectrometer that we ultimately commercialized. I will talk about the process of transitioning from research to commercialization, what it means to be an Entrepreneur, how to find money, and many of the hurdles along the way. I will describe several projects on which I am currently working (I'm working on a beer brewing initiative and new sample introduction techniques, AND the combination of the two) and will include discussion on how to innovate on a budget.
